AQA Química, in its commitment to integrity, transparency and legal compliance, establishes this Anti-Bribery Management System Policy in accordance with the requirements of ISO 37001:2025. Committing to prevent, detect and address any act of bribery in the development of its commercial, technical and administrative activities. The principles that govern the company are:

1. **Zero Tolerance for Bribery:** AQA Química categorically prohibits any form of bribery, both direct and indirect, in all its operations and business relationships.
2. **Legal Compliance:** We are committed to complying with all anti-bribery laws and regulations and other applicable requirements across the board, as well as meeting the requirements of the anti-bribery management system.
3. **Promote the raising** of concerns in good faith or on the basis of a reasonable belief, in confidence, and without fear of reprisal.
4. **Integrity in Business:** We foster an organizational culture based on ethics, transparency, and accountability.
5. **Continuous improvement** of the anti-bribery management system, for the benefit of our stakeholders.
6. **Due Diligence:** We implement risk assessment and due diligence processes to prevent bribery.
7. **We are aware of the negative impact and consequences** which produces in the confidence of our clients and interested parties the failure to comply with the commitments of the policy, as well as the legal and financial consequences.
